

**PARENTAL / LEGAL GUARDIAN CONSENT FORM**  
(For team members under age 21)



**Instructions**

- 1 Fill out this form. **This form must be signed by both parents regardless of their marital status.**
  - **In cases of divorce** both parents must sign this form. If both parents cannot sign, then the person with custody must sign and must attach a notarized copy of the custody papers with this form.
  - **If one or both of the parents are deceased**, a notarized copy of the death certificate(s) must be attached.
  - In all other situations please contact us.
- 2 Have this form notarized.
- 3 Keep this form with you. You might need this form along with a proper ID (Birth Certificate or Passport) in order to enter Honduras.

**NOTE:** This form must be filled out for all minors traveling with you when both parents are not present. Without a **properly filled out and notarized** consent form the authorities may not allow a minor into their country. The reason for this protocol is that authorities are trying to ensure minors do not enter their country against the wishes of the minor's legal guardians.
